

ARTISTS AT WORK

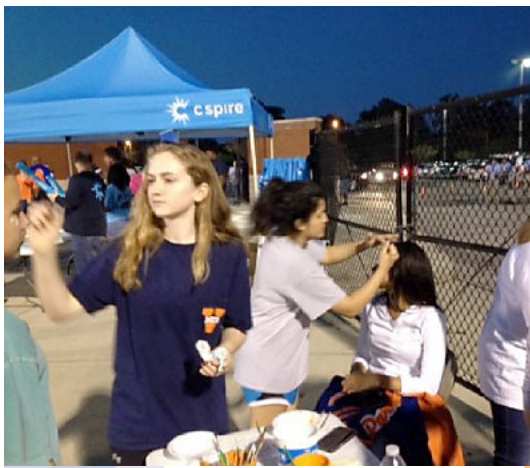
The art club uses their talent to help others.

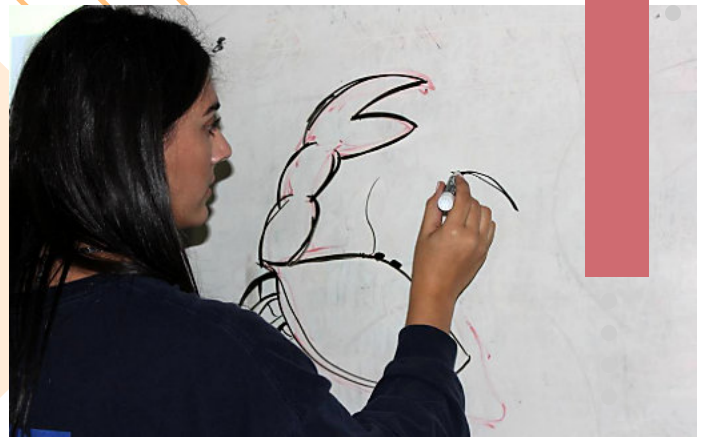

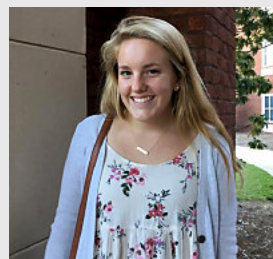


Lindsay Cooper (10) practices her drawing skills on a board.
