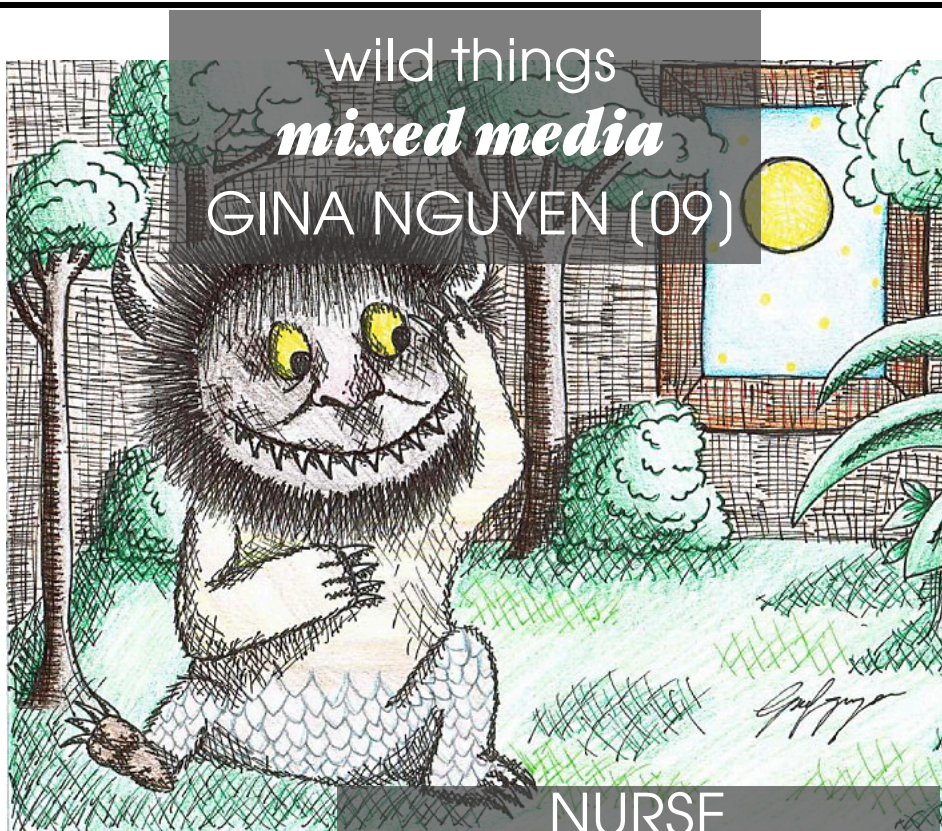


WHIP OUT THE PAINT AND THE SKETCH PADS
