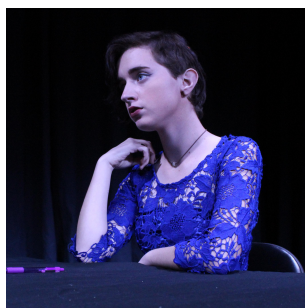
WHEN THE CURTAIN OPENS
