PERSONAL NARRATIVE

All of social media changed once YouTube Shorts, Instagram and FaceBook Reels, and Tik Tok were introduced. All of these tools, except for tik tok, began to get used in the 2021-22 school year. FUTURE

In the future, we plan to use the tik tok more frequently and gain over 1000 followers.

WHY TIK TOK?

TikTok reached 1.92 billion users in 2023. This means that there was a 16% increase from 2022. It is also the #1 downloaded app in more than 40 countries. Therefore, it can be titled the most "trendy" or popular app on the app store.

The app is also very popular among the current generation at Madison Central High School. Many students hope to become "tik tok famous" or "influencers."

Due to this popularity, Jaguar News Network decided to take a chance at creating a tik tok.

Our first tik tok ever made got over 1,200 likes and 15.9K views!
